WINDOWS XP QUICK START GUIDE - IMPORTANT NOTICE

Before connecting the Multicart to the computer, install the Studio software from the CD. The drivers required for the PC to recognize the Multicart correctly are installed at the same time.

INSTALLING THE PC SOFTWARE

Insert the CD into the computer. The Studio Install should start automatically. If not, navigate to your CD drive and run the **USBCOLECO.EXE** program. You will see the welcome screen.



Welcome to Atarimax ColecoVision Multi-Cart Studio Setup program. This program will install Atarimax ColecoVision Multi-Cart Studio on your computer.

When ready, click 'Next'.

The directory where the Studio program will be installed is now shown.

You may change it by clicking on the "Browse" button and selecting a different directory. When ready, click 'Next'.

Enter the name of the Program Manager group to add Atarimax ColecoVision Multi-Cart Studio icons to:

A program folder will be created. If you would like to change the description, type it in now.

When ready, click 'Next'.

Click 'Next' twice to confirm your settings and finish the Multi-Cart Studio software installation.


INSTALLING THE DRIVERS SOFTWARE (Windows XP)

Attach one end of the USB cable to the cartridge and the other directly to a free USB port on your PC. **Do not use a USB hub of any kind for initial setup and testing.**

You should see the new hardware notification bubble appear. Wait a few seconds for the new hardware wizard to begin.




Select 'Install the Software Automatically'.

Click 'Next' to continue. 

The hardware installation wizard will now search your local CD-ROM drive for the appropriate drivers.

A warning may appear saying the driver is 'unsigned'. Press the 'Install Anyway' option to continue.

Driver installation is complete. Press 'Finish' to exit this dialog. 



You can now run the Multi-Cart Studio software and your cartridge status indicator in the program should say **CONNECTED** when the cartridge is plugged in.
